Apply for Pandemic EBT (P-EBT)	 Due to coronavirus (COVID 19), children who are eligible for free or reduced-price meals at school will get extra food benefits. These food benefits are called Pandemic EBT or P-EBT benefits. P-EBT benefits help families in California buy food when school is closed. Children are eligible for P-EBT benefits if: their school is closed due to coronavirus (COVID 19); and they are eligible for free or reduced-price school meals. If you do not get a P-EBT card in the mail, you must apply online by July 15, 2020 to get P-EBT benefits. P-EBT benefits are only available while schools are closed due to coronavirus (COVID 19). If you did not get a P-EBT card in the mail and do not apply by July 15, 2020 you will not be able to get P-EBT benefits. Most families with children who receive CalFresh, Medi-Cal or Foster Care benefits do not need to apply online. They will get their P-EBT card in the mail during the month of May.
