Principal

Raymond Cross – Mr. Cross was appointed to Norma Coombs as Principal in 2022. Prior to that he served six years as an Assistant Principal at Pasadena High School.

Teachers

All of Norma Coombs' classroom teachers are certificated, and are supported by an Instructional Coach, Wellness teacher, and a Response to Intervention teacher (all certificated). There is a part-time Nurse, full-time Health Clerk, and a Behavior Aide.

Every student learns computer coding - instruction and teacher coaching provided by certified Computer Science Impact (CS Impact) instructor.

Norma Coombs: what has changed recently? A new Principal was appointed in 2022, and an extensive campus renovation project was completed in Spring 2019. The school offers an immersive computer coding program (Computer Science Impact) in which coding is integrated into all aspects of learning (K-5). Norma Coombs helped pilot PUSD's Balanced Literacy initiative.

School Environment / Social-Emotional Learning

Positive Recognition: Norma Coombs uses the Second Step program, with weekly social emotional learning lessons provided to each classroom by the Wellness teacher. Students receive positive recognition for demonstrating "Lion's Pride" traits of Respect, Responsibility, and Integrity. Students are recognized at monthly assemblies for both academic and extra-curricular accomplishments.

After-School Programs

After-school Programs: YMCA Adventures, Pasadena Parks and Recreation; variety of fee-based afterschool enrichment programs offered (Can-Do Kids, Kids Klub). Before-school care is available through Pasadena LEARNS and the YMCA.
