

PEN College Planning Resources and Parent Pro-tips

PUSD Aeries/Portal:

- App on computer and phone, save log in info- check frequently to plan classes, check grades, service hours, graduation requirements, etc. Students may need reminders.
- **Pro tip**: Take screenshot of issue, text student w brief questions, direction. Give them suggested deadline, put on your calendar. <u>**Trust but verify**</u> that they're doing what they need to do to achieve their goals.

College Planning websites

- College Board SAT, AP, College Search and Admission Tools
- Have student create an account when they are planning to take PSAT, SAT or AP tests.
 Even if not taking, lots of helpful tools to plan for college, including year by year to do.
 Pro-tip: You may have an account from when you went to college. You'll need to use your student's sign in info to help them stay on track, so have them share their user name and password with you, save on your computer.
- <u>CollegeVine</u>: Can create a list, use an estimator of chances. Not able to download list.
- <u>https://www.collegeconfidential.com/</u>: similar to CollegeVine. Can look for colleges using filters, create lists. Also forum with student input.

<u>FAFSA</u> is the form families must complete so the government and colleges can determine the student's eligibility for grants, scholarships, and loans. This must be completed annually.

The following local programs support low income and first generation students to get into college:

- **Puente Program** at all the high schools; 4-year program within the school; have same English teacher for 9th, 10th, same counselor, get help w class schedule, college applications, fee waivers, more. Expected to do 20 hrs community service per year, 10-15 club hours.
