## PEN's PUSD Elementary Enrichment Guide - "Basics" \& "Extras"

ALL Pasadena Unified elementary schools follow the same basic curriculum, based on California's Common Core State Standards and a project-based learning approach to instruction. With the support of the Pasadena Educational Foundation (PEF) and community partners, PUSD also provides all students with standards-based instruction in visual art and music. All schools have access to technology, that teachers are trained to use technology in instruction, and that all students receive training and opportunities to use technology in learning. There is an increased focus on socialemotional learning at all levels across the district.

## Enrichment "Basics": What EVERY SCHOOL offers

PEN's fact sheets do not include these "basic" enrichment components, but parents should be aware that they are part of every PUSD student's learning, along with core instruction in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies - no matter which school they attend.
-100 minutes/week of structured PE instruction (elementary)

- All $3^{\text {rd }}$ graders participate in a 3-week swim program at the Rose Bowl Aquatic Center
-All TK and Kinder teachers and lead teachers at each of grades 1-5 trained to introduce yoga and meditation practice

＊A note about school size：school enrollment based on 2017－18 school year．While many people like the intimacy of a smaller school，keep in mind that there are trade－offs：fluctuating enrollment can result in forced combo－classes（combined grade levels），and in few or no options among teachers， especially at the higher grade levels．McKinley enrolls approximately 600 in grades TK－5．
